Horn mentioned an upcoming meeting for the Southwest Area Commission and if they can use the Township Hall for a meeting since a church on Brown Road is for sale

Motion to allow SWAC to sue the Township Hall on the 3rd Thursday at 6:30 PM - Leezer made motion, Horn seconded

A resident came to the podium to speak about a tree on 1840 Little Ave with branches falling, with Fleshman responding that a bid will be looked into for removal

Resident Davison came to the podium to ask various questions regarding levies and sewer projects and taps. Fleshman responded to the concerns brought by the Davison.

Carol asked about the Police Levy and Westland Mall, with Fleshman and Leezer responding to the question.

Chief Smith presented 30 days' worth of stats, totaling 1,093 runs in the Township on 1st and 2nd shift, with 131 runs on 3rd shift that the county handled.

Meeting adjourned at 12:55 PM and moved right into a Town Hall Discussion on the Police Levy.
