Special Duty Police Officer's hourly pay will change from \$52.50 to \$62.00 per hour. The police cruiser cost will increase from \$15.00 per hour to \$25.00 per hour. Supervisor when assigned rate of pay per hour will be \$73.00. (Exhibit A)

Special Duty Employer,

Effective January 1, 2023 the hourly rate for special duty Franklin Township personnel will increase as indicated below. This rate increase is a reflection of the current special duty rates of other local law enforcement agencies. The minimum hours of pay for officers will remain at three hours. There are no minimum hours for the Franklin Township vehicle.

Hourly Rate Effective January 1, 2022

Officer \$62.00 \$73.00 Supervisor \$25.00 Vehicle

This increase in the rate for a Franklin Township vehicle is necessary to cover increase in fuel cost, vehicle parts, and maintenance. If three or more officers are needed for an event, a supervisor may also be assigned to the event. If there are less than three offices all officers will be billed at the officer rate.

Sometimes while working a special duty assignment, an officer will be required to take law enforcement action (i.e. make an arrest). If this law enforcement action is directly related to the special duty employment and it becomes necessary to properly process and/or complete the law enforcement action beyond the scheduled ending time, the special duty employer is responsible for payment of the officer's time needed to complete the processing of the law enforcement action.
