A Resolution Approving Special Duty Patrol Car Assignments

The Board of Trustee of Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio met in person in a Regular Session at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, January 24, 2023. The trustee marked below made a motion for the adoption of the following resolution: (check one)

BE IT RESOLVED, the board of township trustees approves and authorizes the following policy pertaining to the use of police cars for special duty assignments regarding the Franklin Township Police Department. There will be no hourly rate charged for police cars that are not actively on patrol while on special duty. Police cars on special duty actively patrolling will be invoiced to the client at the rate of \$25.00 per hour. All unpaid use of a police cruiser must be authorized by the police chief.

BE IT RESOLVED that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.




