
**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.





**ESTIMATED EQUIPMENT** (please complete the shaded fields)

For equipment owned by the public entity, this rate must reflect the original purchase price of the equipment, maintenance costs, time in service, depreciation, freight, fuel, and hauling. The public office may use any generally accepted rate that reflects all of the aforementioned considerations, or it may use the statewide rates as published by the Ohio Department of Transportation and updated on a quarterly basis; however, the office must use the same rate source for all equipment used in a project.
