**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP ADMINSTRATOR

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio that the Board adopts, approves, and authorizes the execution of the Township's Police Department, Capital City Lodge FOP 9 contract for the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2026. The contract is retroactive to July 1, 2023, to include any agreed upon benefits and pay increases negotiated openly and fairly between the Township and the Union members. (See Exhibit A)



Extension Agreement
