Section 2. The Fiscal Officer be and hereby is authorized and directed to certify a copy of said budget and a copy of this Resolution and to transmit the same to the Franklin County Budget Commission on or before August 5, 2024.

Section 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all deliberations of this Board that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
