**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Auditor's Office has made it possible for Advances on Real Estate Tax Settlements to be distributed via electronic transfer; now, therefore.

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Franklin Township Board of Trustees requests an advance on all funds, as they become available during the calendar year 2025, from the Franklin County Auditor's Office. (See Exhibit A)

Section 2. That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency and be effective immediately upon its adoption.


