CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT CONTRIBUTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN CITY OF COLUMBUS, OHIO

AND

FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR

ATHENS AVENUE AND RUMSEY ROAD AREA WATER LINE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, C.I.P. Number 690236-100136

This Contribution Agreement (the "AGREEMENT") is made and entered into the ____ _, 2025 (the "Effective Date"), by and between the City of Columbus, Ohio MAJ acting through its Director of Public Utilities, pursuant to and under the authority of Ordinance No. 0081-2025, passed February 3, 2025, hereinafter designated as the CITY, and the Franklin Township Board of Trustees, hereinafter designated as FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP; collectively referred to as the Parties; and

WHEREAS, the CITY is engaged in the administering the Athens Avenue and Rumsey Road Area Water Line Improvements project (the "Project"), the work for which includes replacement of water mains which have exceeded their useful life and construction of new lines to eliminate poor fire flow capabilities and poor water quality. The project work also includes repair of roads dug up to perform the water line work. Franklin Township requested, and the Department of Public Utilities has agreed, to incorporate the pavement milling and resurfacing of the south travel lane on Briggs Road, from Brixham Road to Demorest Road, into the plans while the Department of Public Utilities is doing work on the portion of the same road within the Columbus city limits; and

WHEREAS, FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP has committed \$48,783.00 toward that effort; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 0081-2025 authorized the CITY to enter into agreement with and to accept funds from FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP in furtherance of the Project; and

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereto do hereby covenant and agree, as follows:

1. **DEFINITIONS:**

- A. "Contract Documents" shall mean collectively: a) this AGREEMENT, including attachments/exhibits.
- B. "Contribution" means the monies contributed by FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP to the CITY toward the cost of the "Work" performed.
- C. "Work" means the incorporation of the pavement milling and resurfacing of the south travel lane on Briggs Road, from Brixham Road to Demorest Road as requested by FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP.

- 2. <u>GENERAL CONSIDERATIONS</u>: In consideration of the promises of the COUNTY set forth herein, the CITY shall perform, or cause to be performed, the Work defined herein.
- 3. <u>CONTRIBUTION</u>: FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP shall contribute \$48,783.00 toward costs associated with the completion of the Work defined herein. Funds in the amount stated above shall be deposited with the CITY following the execution of this AGREEMENT.

- 4. <u>LEGAL JURISDICTION</u>: All claims, counterclaims, disputes and other matters in question between FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP, its agents and employees, and the CITY, its contractors, subcontractors and agents arising out of or relating to this AGREEMENT or its breach will be decided in a court of competent jurisdiction within the County of Franklin, State of Ohio.
- 5. ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This AGREEMENT shall constitute the entire agreement between FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP and the CITY and shall supersede all prior agreements, proposals, representations, negotiations and letters of intent, whether written or oral, pertaining to the Work.
- 6. <u>COUNTERPARTS AND ACCEPTANCE</u>: This AGREEMENT may be executed in multiple counterparts, which shall together constitute a single document, and may be executed by one or more Parties using an electronic signature. However, this AGREEMENT shall not be effective unless and until all requisite signatures have been obtained. Acceptance, for purposes hereof, shall mean that each Party is in possession of a fully executed counterpart copy or original of this AGREEMENT.
