

In Ohio, a Managed Care Organization (MCO) is a state-certified entity that manages the medical aspects of workers' compensation claims, working in partnership with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (BWC). MCOs handle claim filing, medical treatment, and return-to-work programs.
