Resolution to Reopen Station 193 Upon Passage of the Fire Levy

The Board of Trustee of Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio, met in person in a Regular Meeting at 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 16th, 2026, at 2193 Frank Road, Columbus, Ohio. The Trustee marked below made a motion for the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the continued provision of fire and emergency services is essential to the safety and well-being of the community; and **WHEREAS**, Station 193 has been closed due to funding limitations; and

WHEREAS, the passage of a fire levy would provide additional financial resources to support fire and emergency operations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that upon the approval and passage of the fire levy, Station 193 shall be reopened as funding becomes available; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the reopening and staffing of Station 193 shall be prioritized upon the receipt and allocation of levy funds, and implemented in a manner consistent with operational and budgetary priorities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of this Board and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code. Section 4.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.


