A Resolution Establishing a Township Hall and Property Rental Agreement and Fee Schedule

The Board of Trustee of Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio, met in person in a Regular Meeting at 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 28th, 2026, at 2193 Frank Road, Columbus, Ohio. The Trustee marked below made a motion for the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 503.25, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10, and Ohio Revised Code Section 505.12, the Board of Trustees of Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio (“Board”), is authorized to acquire, maintain, supervise, regulate, and manage township property and township buildings, including township halls and meeting facilities; and

WHEREAS the Board finds it necessary and proper to establish policies, procedures, rental terms, conditions of use, and fees governing the use of the Franklin Township Hall in order to protect Township property, preserve public resources, and promote orderly public access; and

WHEREAS the Board desires to establish a uniform Township Hall Rental Agreement, Rules of Use, and Fee Schedule applicable to all non-Township uses of Township facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio, as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE

- Establish procedures governing use of the Franklin Township Hall and related Township properties;
- Adopt a Township Hall Rental Agreement and Rules of Use; (Exhibit A)
- Establish a fee schedule for use of Township facilities; and (Exhibit B)
- Protect Township property and ensure fair and orderly public access.

SECTION 2. AUTHORITY

This Resolution is adopted pursuant to the authority granted to boards of township trustees under Ohio law, including Ohio Revised Code Section 503.25, Ohio Revised Code Section 505.10, and Ohio Revised Code Section 505.12.

SECTION 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Board in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption.
