A Resolution Authorizing The Administrative Assistant To Proceed With Nuisance Property Abatement Cleanup Services During Calendar Year 2026

The Board of Trustee of Franklin Township, Franklin County, Ohio, met in person in a Regular Meeting at 12:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 28th, 2026, at 2193 Frank Road, Columbus, Ohio. The Trustee marked below made a motion for the adoption of the following resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of Franklin Township finds it necessary to address nuisance properties in a timely and efficient manner; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to establish requirements and spending limitations for nuisance property abatement cleanup services during calendar year 2026;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Franklin Township that the Administrative Assistant, Nicole Randazzio, shall obtain three (3) quotes for nuisance property abatement cleanup services whenever reasonably possible and is authorized to proceed with and contract for the lowest responsive quote, provided the total cost does not exceed Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) per parcel and sufficient appropriated funds are available within the appropriate Township fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that if three (3) quotes cannot reasonably be obtained, the Administrative Assistant shall maintain documentation demonstrating reasonable attempts to solicit three (3) quotes and may proceed with the lowest available responsive quote within the spending limitations authorized herein.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any nuisance abatement cleanup cost exceeding Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) per parcel shall require prior approval by the Board of Trustees.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this authorization shall remain in effect through December 31, 2026, and all expenditures authorized herein shall be contingent upon available appropriated funds within the appropriate Township fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to this Resolution were passed in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be in full force and effective immediately upon its adoption.
